





LA MOUSSIÈRE ROUGE BIODYNAMIC ORGANIC



TASTING NOTES

The La MoussiÄ"re Rouge 2018 (100% Pinot Noir), is produced from vines between 5 and 45 years old and is certified organic and biodynamic. Winemaking is all about preserving the delicate aromas and characteristics of the varietal. The grapes undergo a cold maceration before a delicate pressing before being pumped into casks for malolactic fermentation. Then 80-100% new French oak casks are used for ageing on fine lees over 10-18 months. The wine has bright fruit flavours of raspberries, currants, mulberries and morello cherries, with spicy traces of pink peppercorns, vanilla and cinnamon. It is mellow, well rounded and well structured. The

oak is well-integrated with warming spice on the finish.
