The colour of this Pouilly-Fuissé is a bright straw yellow. The bouquet of vanilla, butter, ripe red apples, and honeysuckle entices to taste the wine and embodies the uniqueness of its origin. Ripe citrus fruits and low to moderate acidity with chalky accents on the palate. Overall, a wine with good length and complexity.
