Made from grapes grown at 3,280 feet above sea-level in an incredible vineyard discovered in the 1970s by Hubert Tiefenbrunner - the first producer to ever venture so high in search of freshness and incredible aromatics. This zesty mineral Müller-Thurgau is light straw-yellow in colour with greenish reflexes. It is intensely aromatic with notes of white flowers and yellow fruits, peach and apricot. With increasing age, the mineral notes can come to the forefront. A delicate body with elegant harmony, succulence and fresh acidity.
